After a 42 year old man was involved in a drunken brawl he was left with severe memory recall problems, prolonged period of post traumatic amnesia, and also received frontal lobe damage affecting his personality. Whilst in the rehabilitation centre Allied's Support Workers were introduced to the gentleman, by working

alongside the care staff they were able to develop a support package allowing him to return home. Within 6 months his level of support was reduced, and he is now capable of living independently with some support for managing his finances, shopping, accommodation and attending support groups.
